## Alzheimer's Respite\*

### Home Health & Hospice Care

Assistance to families relieving the stress of 24-hour care with companion, aide and/or nursing services

*People to be helped: 18 families*

\$9,708

## CARE-Dental Services\*

### Nashua Pastoral Care Center

Collaborative proposal with referrals through Pastoral Care and dental services by Greater Nashua Dental Connection

*People to be helped: 353 individuals receiving 664 clinic visits*

\$25,678

## Comprehensive Health Care for the Uninsured\*

### Nashua Area Health Center

Health care services for low-income men, women, and children

*People to be helped: 4,005 individuals receiving 11,971 clinic visits*

\$38,833

## Counseling Uninsured Children\*

### The Youth Council

Drug and alcohol abuse counseling for children and teens

*People to be helped: 350 individuals receiving 2,800 counseling sessions*

\$17,475

## Home Health Services/ Licensed Nursing Assistant\*

### Home Health & Hospice Care

Subsidized in-home health aide visits to recovering discharged hospital patients and the elderly for assistance with daily living

*People to be helped: 64 individuals receiving 2,765 hours of care*

\$4,854

## Hospice Care\*

### Home Health & Hospice Care

Care and support of the terminally ill and their families

*People to be helped: 112 families*

\$4,854

## Maternal & Child Health

### Home Health & Hospice Care

Well-child, immunization and health clinics for low-income and uninsured children and teens, plus home-based services to infants, children and parents

*People to be helped: 110 individuals receiving 1,400 care visits*

\$8,000

## Prevention Connection\*

### Girls Inc. of NH

Career awareness, economic and media literacy programming targeting academically & economically disadvantaged girls ages 12-17/Critical thinking skills, personal safety strategies and substance abuse prevention for girls and boys ages 5-17.

*People to be helped: 4,200 individuals*

## Senior Foot Care Clinics\*

### Home Health & Hospice Care

Foot soaks, nail reductions, and removal of corns/calluses by registered nurses at senior centers and housing complexes

*People to be helped: 17 individuals*

*receiving 66 clinic visits*

\$1,942
